Lazarus House, a gospel-based ministry in Lawrence, MA, first opened its doors in 1983 as a five bed emergency shelter for the homeless. It now provides a continuum of services to over 8,000 people a month who are in dire need of life's most basic necessities. A dedicated team from WPC has been preparing a hot breakfast for 60 people at Lazarus House's Good Shepherd Center each Monday morning since 2006. Seeing the incredible

value of this ministry we decided to make it a part of our missions budget beginning in 2012. The mission of Lazarus House is "to see the face of Jesus in all people we have the privilege to serve." Other services include a food pantry, homeless shelter, AIDS home, transitional apartments, thrift stores, job training and English lessons.
