

Mission Trips

2011 ECUADOR: Sixteen people traveled to For His Children Orphanage (FHC) in Quito, Ecuador to serve the children and staff. Many of the 50 children cared



for at FHC are living with significant disabilities, requiring a high level of individual care. Team members helped to care for and play with the children, introduced a music program, painted indoors, and constructed a puppet theater and shelving. In addition, they served in a local soup kitchen. One day was spent visiting children sponsored through Compassion International. This was our fourth

trip to this orphanage.

2013 WAR, WEST VIRGINIA: A team of adults and young people returned to this extremely poor county in West Virginia for the fifth year in a row, spending a week working with Hope Force International under the leadership of Craig Snow. Team members repaired roofs, painted, did light construction work and visited with grateful home owners.

2012 RWANDA: This was our fourth mission team to Rwanda. In 2010 we spent



two weeks beginning a relationship working with Mercy Ministries in the Gisenyi area, as well as returning to Gahanga Orphanage for handicapped children, Muhumurize school for street children in Kigali and visiting children sponsored by our church through Compassion International. A return trip is likely in 2014 or 2015.

2014 Haiti Youth and adult advisors plan a trip to Haiti in July, 2014 to work on house construction.
